DoD ECA Medium Assurance certificates are issued under the Department of Defense External Certificate Authority program and are used to conduct business with the DoD and other government entities.

This certificate is stored in your browser certificate store on your local PC or laptop.

Identity Authentication Method:	Your identity must be verified by a Notary Public, IdenTrust Registrar or Authorized Trusted Agent
Identity Proofing Requirements:	Proof of identity and proof of citizenship
Forms Packet Required:	Yes - You are required to submit a forms packet with your application
Trust Model:	This certificate is trusted by the U.S. Government
Assurance Level:	Medium Assurance
Type of Certificate:	This is an affiliated certificate that is issued to you and your sponsoring organization
Validity Periods:	Available in one (1), two (2) and three (3) year validity periods
Storage Type:	Browser certificate store of a single PC or laptop
Available to Non-U.S. Residents:	No - See our DoD ECA Medium Assurance Foreign Certificate
